## SHORT DESCRIPTION

**Be a ChangeMaker** is an international Training Course that involves 36 participants from 9 countries : Germany, Georgia, Poland , Armenia, Croatia, Romania, Lithuania, Greece and Turkey (4 participants from each country).

- ✓ Share and discuss experiences, examples, and possibilities of working towards recognition in different societies.

**Target group:** 4 participants; Age from 18 - without age limit from each country.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITY AND METHODOLOGY:** Various non-formal education methods will be used during the TC to achieve planned objectives.

## ***The venue and accommodation***

Participants of the Youth Exchange will stay at the hotel in Kobuleti - a resort of the Black Sea.

The participants will be accommodating in the rooms with 2-3 beds, the toilets, air-conditioners and shower- baths are in all rooms of the hotel. Each participant will have a separate bed. Towels, bed-linen is provided.

### **Medical safety:**

### **Insurance:**

Each participant must have health insurance. The cost of insurance is not funded.

### **Food:**

The breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided at the hotel. The participants must inform us forward about their dietary (vegetarian, don't eat a pork etc) or any specific needs.

## ***Currency***

Currency in Georgia: Lari (GEL), 1 Lari = 100 Tetri

Exchange rate is approximately (today): 1 USD = 2.80 GEL 1 EURO = 3 GEL

None from the currencies will not be accepted in the trade centers, cafe, pub, and restaurant or by the taxi except of GEL. Exchange of money is accessible as at the airport, also in Kobuleti.
